An Act to amend the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance

[8TH MARCH, 1963]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Tanganyika.

1. This Act may be cited as the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance (Amendment) Act, 1963, and shall be read as one with the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as the Ordinance).

2. Section 4 of the Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting sub-section (4) thereof and substituting therefor the following new sub-section:—

Section 4

“(4) The Board may conduct its business either at meetings of the Board or by circulation of papers:

Provided that—

(i) any decision of the Board, if taken at a meeting, shall, subject to the provisions of subsection (5), require the concurrence of the majority of the members present and voting at the meeting and, if taken on a circulation of papers, shall require the concurrence of the majority of the members of the Board;

(ii) where any business is conducted by circulation of papers, any member of the Board may require any such business to be referred to a meeting of the Board.”

3. The Ordinance is hereby amended by adding immediately after section 44 thereof the following new section to be numbered 44A:—

“Power to
delegate

44A. The Minister may by order published in the *Gazette* empower the Board to delegate to any member thereof or to the registrar any function conferred upon the Board by this Ordinance or by any rules made under this Ordinance.”
