An Act to amend the Public Holidays Ordinance

[11TH DECEMBER, 1964]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Public Holidays Ordinance Short title (Amendment) Act, 1964, and shall be read as one with the Public Cap. 35 Holidays Ordinance.
- 2. The Schedule to the Public Holidays Ordinance is hereby repealed Schedule to principal Ordinance repealed ordinance repealed and replaced and replaced by the following new Schedule: -

New Year's Day (1st January) Zanzibar Revolutionary Day (12th January) The two days upon which the festival of Id-el-Fitr is celebrated Good Friday Easter Monday The two days upon which the festival of Id-el-Haj is celebrated Union Day (26th April) International Workers Day (1st May) Saba Saba Day (7th July) Maulidi Day Tanganyika Independence and Republic Day (9th December) Christmas Day Boxing Day.".
