I ASSENT.

An Act to amend the Pensions Ordinance

[9TH JULY, 1965]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

1. This Act may be cited as the Pensions Ordinance (Amendment) Short title Act, 1965, and shall be read as one with the Pensions Ordinance (herestruction Cap. 371

- 2. Section 4 of the Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the full Section 4 of stop at the end of subsection (5) and by adding the following "or of Cap. 371 amended his death in the public service.

Section 20 of

- (a) by deleting the colon at the end of paragraph (v) of subsection Cap. 371 amended (1) thereof and by substituting therefor a semi-colon;
- (b) by adding immediately below paragraph (v) of subsection (1) thereof the following words and new paragraphs:-

"or if the deceased officer was or had been a married woman-

- (vi) if the deceased officer leaves a child who is, or children who are, wholly or mainly dependent upon her for support at the time of her death (whether or not his or their father is alive), a pension in respect of each child, until such child attains the age of twenty-one years, of an amount not exceeding one-quarter of the amount prescribed under paragraph (i);
- (vii) if the deceased officer leaves a mother who is wholly or mainly dependent upon her for support at the time of her death, a pension to the mother, while of good character and without adequate means of support, of an amount not exceeding the amount prescribed under paragraph (i);";

- (c) by inserting in paragraph (a) of the proviso to subsection (1), immediately after the word, figure and symbol "paragraph (v)", the following words, figure and symbol "or paragraph (vii)";
- (d) by adding immediately below subsection (7) the following new subsection:—

"(8) Notwithstanding anything in this section contained it shall be lawful for the appropriate authority to review any pension granted under this section and to make such alteration thereto (either by way of increasing or reducing the same) as the appropriate authority may in the circumstances deem fit.".

4. The Schedule to the Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting in the appropriate alphabetical position in the schedule to regulation 14, the words "Interim Commissioner for the West Indies".
