An Act to apply a sum of seven thousand and seventy-two million seven hundred and four thousand four hundred shillings out of the Consolidated Fund to the Service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-seven, to appropriate the supply granted for such year, to authorize the reallocation of certain appropriations and to provide for matters incidental thereto and connected therewith

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1976.
- (2) The expressions used m this Act shall have the meanings respectively ascribed thereto in the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance.
- **2.** The Treasury may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply towards the supply granted for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1977 the sum of seven thousand and seventy-two million seven hundred and four thousand four hundred shillings.
- **3.** The sum granted by section 2 shall be appropriated to the purposes and in the amounts specified in the second, third and fourth columns respectively of the First Schedule to this Act.
- **4.** The Minister may, by certificate under his hand, raise the sums of moneys appropriated by the First Schedule hereto for any of the purposes specified in the second column of the Second Schedule hereto

Appropriation of money voted

Provision for further Appropriation by such further sum or sums of money not exceeding in aggregate the amounts specified in the third and fourth columns of the said Second Schedule in relation to such purpose, and where such a certificate is issued the amount specified therein shall be a charge on and be paid out of the Consolidated Fund, and the provisions of sections 2 and 3 shall take effect as if the total sum granted out of the Consolidated Fund, and the amounts appropriated for the purpose specified in such certificate were raised by the amount or amounts specified in the certificate.

Powers of Minister to borrow

- **5.** (1) The Minister may, at any time or times not later than the thirtieth day of June, 1977, borrow within or outside the United Republic or partly within and partly outside the United Republic any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole the total sum granted or deemed to have been granted out of the Consolidated Fund by virtue of the provisions of section 2 by way of loan, advance, the issue of bills or bank overdraft and on such, terms and conditions as the Minister may deem, expedient, and may charge any such loan or advance on any of the assets of the United Republic (including securities forming part of the Consolidated Fund).
- (2) Any money borrowed under this section shall be placed to the credit of the exchequer account and shall form part of the Consolidated Fund, and be available in any manner in which such Fund is available.
- (3) Any money borrowed under this section shall be subject to repayment not later than the thirty-first day'of October, 1977 and any sum required for the repayment of any money'so borrowed, and of any interest payable thereon shall be charged on and paid out of the Consolidated Fund.

(4) The powers conferred upon the Minister by this section shall be in additional to the powers of the ministers under the government loans, Guarantees and Grants Act, 1974.

Powers of Minister to reallocate certain Appropriated moneys

- **6.**-(1) Where the Minister is satisfied that it is necessary in the public interest that provision should be made for defraying the expenditure of any Ministry or Department of the, Government in excess of any sum voted there for or for any service for which no sum is voted, and that It Would be detrimental to the public interest, to postpone such expenditure until provision can be made there for by the National Assembly, he may, notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in this Act or any other written law, authorize the application of, any surplus arising on any vote in the First Schedule hereto (other than the votes for pensions, gratuities or other retirement benefits, or for widows and orphans pensions) for or towards such excess or service.
- (2) Where the Minister authorizes the application of any surplus under this section, he shall cause to be laid before the National Assembly, not later than at the meeting next after the date of such as the case may be, in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution.

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- (3) The Minister may delegate all or any of the powers conferred upon him by this section to any public officer subject to such limitations; as the Minister may specify.
- (4:) The provisions of section 20 of the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance, shall not apply to the powers conferred upon the Minister by this section.
- **7.** The sums required from time to time for the Subsidiary Funds and Repayments in respect of the 5¾ per cent Inscribed Stock, 1978/82 (68,571,600) is hereby charged up-on and shall be paid out of the Consolidated Fund.
