**An Act to amend the College of African Wildlife Management Act, 1964**

[1ST JANUARY, 1975]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

1. This Act may be cited as the College of African Wildlife (Amendment) Act, 1974, shall be read as one with the College of African Wildlife Management Act, 1964 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act") and shall come into operation on the first day of January, 1975.

2. The principal Act is amended by adding immediately below section 18 the following new section

19. The Minister may give to the Governing Body directions of a general character as to the exercise and performance by the Governing Body of its functions in relation to matters appearing to the Minister to affect the national interest and the Governing Body shall give effect to every such direction.

20. The Governing Body shall afford to the Minister facilities for obtaining information with respect to the property and activities of the College and shall furnish him with returns, accounts, and other information with respect thereto and afford to him facilities for the verification of information furnished, in such manner and at such times as the Minister may require.

21. In appointing members of the Governing Body' the Minister shall have regard to the desirability of fostering and maintaining friendly relations with other countries interested in the protection of African fauna."

**3.** The Schedule to the principal Act is amended by deleting paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 thereof and substituting therefor the following new paragraphs: -

"Construc-  
tion

**1.** In this Schedule unless the context, otherwise requires-  
"appointing authority" means, in relation to the Chairman  
of the Governing Body, the President and in relation to  
any other member, the Minister;  
"member" includes the Chairman.

2.-(1) The Governing Body shall consist of-

- (a) a Chairman, who shall be appointed by the President;  
and
- (b) not less than eleven and not more than fifteen other  
members appointed by the Minister.

(2) Every member of the Governing Body shall continue  
to hold office until his appointment is revoked by the  
appointing authority.

3. Where any member absents himself from three con-  
secutive meetings of the Governing Body without reasonable  
excuse the Governing Body shall advise the appointing autho-  
rity of the fact and the appointing authority may terminate  
the appointment of the member and appoint another member  
in his place."
