## An Act to amend Certain Written Laws

40

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

1. This Act may be cited as the Written Laws (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act, 1981.

paragraph 4 and substituting for it the following new paragraph:

"Tenure appointment

**4.** A member of the Council shall, unless his appointment is sooner determined by the appointing authority, or he otherwise ceases to be a member, hold office for such period as the appointing authority may specify in the instrument of his appointment, or if no period is so specified, shall hold office for a term of three years from the date of his appointment, and shall be eligible for re-appointment."

The Pharmaceuticals The Pharmaceuticals, and Poison, and Poisons Act, 1979 is hereby amended by adding immediately below section 72 the following new section:

> "General Penalty

10

72A.--(1) Any person who commits an offence under this

Act for which no specific penalty is provided, shall be liable, in the case of a first offence, to a fine not exceeding two thousand shillings or to a sentence of imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months and, in the case of second offence, to a fine not exceeding six thousand shillings, and in the case of a subsequent offence, to a fine not exceeding ten thousand shillings

(2) Where tile court is of tile opinion, in the case of second or subsequent offence, that a fine will not meet the circumstances Or the case and that the offence was committed through the personal act, default or culpable negligence of the accused person, it may, ill lieu of or in addition to any fine. impose a sentence Of imprisonment for a term not exceeding four years,"

Acts, 1973 No. 2

The Sisal Industry Act, The Sisal Industry Act, 1973, is here by amended in section 2 by deleting the definition "Sisal" and substituting for it the following definition:

"Sisal" means the plant Sisalama or other Species of Genius Agave or of the hybrids of any such species and fibre thereof and includes brush tow, flume tow, carded tow and other substances or by products derived therefrom.

Acts, 1974 No. 1

The Aerodromes (Licerising and ControL Act,

The Aerodromes (Licensing and Control) Act 1974 is hereby amended in Section 2 bdeleting the words "civil aviation" which appear under the definition "Minister" and substituting for them the word "works".
