I ASSENT.

An Act to apply a sum of twenty thousand, seven hundred forty-nine million, six hundred thirty-four thousand, three hundred shillings out of the Consolidated Fund to the Service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1985, to appropriate the supply granted for that year, to authorize the reallocation of certain appropriations and to provide for matters connected with those purposes

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

- 1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1984.
- (2) The expressions used in this Act shall each have the meaning and interpretaascribed to it in the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance.

Short title

2. The Treasury may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply Issue of towards the supply granted for the service of the year ending on the Shs. thirtieth day of June, 1985, the sum of twenty thousand, seven hundred out of Conforty-nine million, six hundred thirty-four thousand, three hundred solidated shillings.

3. The sum granted by section 2 shall be appropriated to the purposes Appropria-and in, amounts specified in the second, third and fourth columns tion of respectively of the First Schedule to this Act.

4.—(1) The Minister may at any time or times not later than the Power of thirtieth day of June, 1985, borrow within or outside the United the Minister Republic or partly within and partly outside the United Republic, to borrow any sum or sums not exceeding the whole of the total sum granted or deemed to have been granted out of the Consolidated Fund by virtue of the provisions of section 2 by way of loan, advance, the issue of bills or bank overdraft and on such terms and conditions as the Minister may deem expedient, and may charge that loan or advance on any of the assets of the United Republic, including securities forming part of the Consolidated Fund.

- (2) Any money borrowed under this section shall be placed to the credit of the exchequer account and shall form part of the Concolidated Fund, and be available in any manner in which that fund is available.
- (3) Any money borrowed under this section shall be subject to repayment not later than the thirty-first day of October, 1985, and any sum required for the repayment of any money so borrowed, and of any interest payable in respect of that money shall be charged on and paid out of the Consolidated Fund.
- (4) The powers conferred upon the Minister by this section shall be in addition to the powers of the Minister under the Government Loans, Guarantees and Grants Act, 1974.

Power of Minister to reallocate certain appropriated moneys

- 5.—(1) Where the Minister is satisfied that it is necessary in the public interest that provision be made for defraying the expenditure of any Region, Ministy or Department of the Government in excess of any sum voted for it or for any service for which no sum is voted, and that it would be detrimental to the public interest to postpone the expenditure until provision lan be made for it by the National Assembly, he may notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in this Act or any other written law, authorize the application of any surplus arising out of any vote in the First Schedule to this Act (other than the votes for pensions, gratuities or other retirement benefits, or for widows' and orphans' pension) for or towards the excess or service.
- (2) Where the Minister authorizes the application of any surplus under this section, he shall cause to be laid before the National authorization, a supplementary estimates Bill or statement of reallocation as the case may be, in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution.
- (3) The Minister may delegate all or any of the powers conferred upon him by this section to any public officer subject to such limitations as the Minister may specify.

(4) The provisions of section 20 of the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance shall not apply to the powers conferred upon the Minister by this section.
