An Act to amend certain written laws

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

1. This Act may be cited as the Written Laws (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act, 1992.
2. The various laws set forth in the first and second columns of this Act are amended in the manner specified in the third column.

The Civil Aviation Act

The Act is amended in PART III by inserting the following new parts "IIIA & IIIB" between Part III and Part IV:

"PART III A

The Secretariat

THE SECRETARIAT OF THE CIVIL AVIATION BOARD

9A (1) There shall be a Secretariat of the Civil Aviation Board whose functions shall be to assist the Board in the exercise of its functions under this Act.

(2) The members of the secretariat shall be appointed by the Minister and shall perform executive functions as may be directed by the Director General who shall be an ex- official member of the Board.

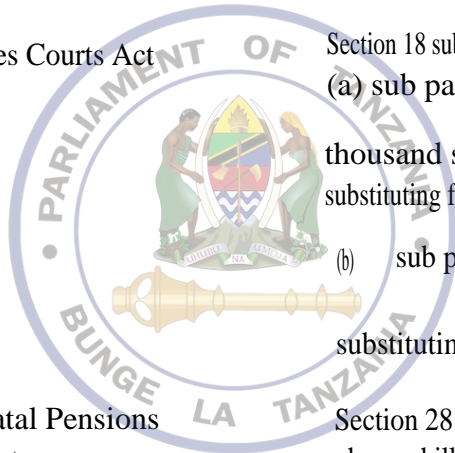
