REGULATIONS

(Made under section 33)

THE IMMIGRATION (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2016

Citation G.N.No.657 of 1997 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Regulations, 2016 and shall be read as one with the Immigration Regulations 1997, hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations".

General amendments

2. The principal Regulations are amended generally by deleting the phrase "Principal Commissioner" wherever it appears in the Regulations and substituting for it the phrase "Commissioner General".

Amendment of Regulation 3. The principal Regulations is amended in regulation 4 by deleting subregulation (1) and substituting for it the following-

"(1) There shall be paid in respect of the several matters provide for in the first to third column of the tables provided in the Second schedule to these Regulations the fee set out in the proceeding columns of the respective tables to the Second Schedule."

Amendment of Regulation 17 G.N. No. 541 of 2015

- 4. The principal Regulations is amended in regulation 17:
- (a) by deleting sub regulation (1) and substituting for it the following-

"Student Pass

17.-(1) A Student Pass may be issued by an Immigration Officer to any person who has been admitted as a student in an approved training establishment in the United Republic for purposes of undertaking studies or

training.

- (2) For the purposes of these Regulations "training establishment" includes registered Kindergarten, Primary and secondary schools and other higher learning institutions."
- (b) by renumbering sub regulations (2) to (9) as sub regulations (3) to (10) respectively.
- (c) in the renumbered sub regulation (4) by adding the words "using TIF form No. 21 as prescribed in the First Schedule." immediately after the word "Pass" appearing at the end of that sub regulation.
- (d) by deleting the renumbered sub regulation (5) and substituting for it the following
 - "(5) A Student Pass shall, subject to such terms and conditions-
 - (a) be issued using TIF. form No.22 as prescribed in the First Schedule;
 - (b) be issued for a period not exceeding two years and shall be renewed annually, for the duration of the study or training."
- 5. The principal Regulations is amended in regulation 18:
- (a) by deleting sub regulation (1) and (2) and substituting for it the following-

"Migrant pass

- 18.-(1) A person of African descent from a bordering country who migrated into the United Republic before the year 1972 various reasons and has continuously living in the United Republic without having a **Passport** Identification Document of any other Country shall not reside in the United Republic unless he obtains a migrant pass issued accordance with in these Regulations.
- (2) A person may, upon application in Form TIF.23 as prescribed in the First schedule, be issued with a migrant pass by an issuing officer, except that the applicant shall be a person who-
 - (a) has adequate knowledge of

- Kiswahili and any local dialect:
- (b) has not been convicted of an offence and sentenced to imprisonment for a term of three years or longer; and
- (c) intends to continue to reside in the United Republic upon being issued with the Migrant Pass.
- (3) A Migrant Pass shall -
 - (a) be issued in Form TIF 24 as prescribed in First Schedule; and
 - (b) be issued at Immigration
 Department Headquarters
 Dar es salaam, Head Office
 Zanzibar or any
 Immigration office as may
 be directed by the Principal
 Commissioner of
 Immigration Services."
- (b) by renumbering sub regulation (3) to (5) as sub regulation (4) to (6) respectively.

Amendment of By: Regulation 19 G.N. No. 541 of 2015

- 6. The principal Regulations is amended in regulation 19
- (a) deleting sub regulation (1) and substituting for it the following-

"Business Pass

- 19.-(1) A person who seeks to enter or remain in the United Republic for the purpose of temporarily conducting business, trade, profession or assignment shall not reside in the United Republic for that purpose unless with a valid Business Pass issued in accordance with these Regulations."
- (b) Inserting immediately after sub regulation (2) a new sub regulation (3) as follows-
 - (3) A person may, upon application in

Form TIF.25 as prescribed in the First schedule, be issued with a business pass by an immigration officer.

- (c) deleting sub regulation (3) and substituting for it the following-
 - (4) A Business Pass shall-
 - (a) be issued in Form TIF 26 as prescribed in the First Schedule
 - (b) be issued at the designated entry points, Immigration Department Headquarters Dar es salaam, Head Office Zanzibar or any Immigration office as may be directed by the Principal Commissioner."
- (d) renumbering sub regulation (4) as sub regulation (5).

Amendment of First Schedule 6. The principal Regulations is amended in the First Schedule by adding immediately after Form TIF.20, the following-
