

An Act to amend certain Financial Laws

[14TH SEPTEMBER, 1970]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Financial Laws (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No. 2) Act, 1970. Short title and commencement

(2) Section 2 shall be deemed to have come into operation on the fourteenth day of September, 1970.

(3) Section 3 shall come into operation on the first day of December, 1970.

2. The Schedule to the Private Motor Vehicles Registration Tax Act, 1964, is amended by deleting paragraph 2 and substituting therefor the following paragraph:— Amendment to the Private Motor Vehicles Registration Tax Act, 1964 Cap. 562

“2. In the case of a new vehicle the registration tax shall be—

- (a) where the vehicle is a motor cycle, fifteen per centum of the value of the motor cycle;
- (b) where the vehicle is a passenger car, a station wagon, shooting brake or similar vehicle—
 - (i) if the maximum cylinder capacity of the vehicle does not exceed 1200 c.c., a sum equal to thirty-five per centum of the value of the vehicle;
 - (ii) if the maximum cylinder capacity of the vehicle exceeds 1200 c.c., but does not exceed 1800 c.c., a sum equal to forty per centum of the value of the vehicle;
 - (iii) if the maximum cylinder capacity of the vehicle exceeds 1800 c.c., but does not exceed 2250 c.c., a sum equal to fifty-five per centum of the value of the vehicle;

- (iv) if the maximum cylinder capacity of the vehicle exceeds 2250 c.c., a sum equal to seventy-five per centum of the value of the vehicle;
- (c) where the vehicle is a van, pick-up or similar vehicle of less than three tons carrying capacity, thirty-five per centum of the value of the vehicle.”

3. The Foreign Commercial Vehicles (Licensing) Act, 1970 is amended in subsection (1) of section 2, in the definition “commercial vehicle” by deleting the word “eight” which occurs in the sixth line and substituting therefor the word “six”.
